## Employment

As an emerging, self-employed artist in ceramics since 2019, I currently create funeral urns and other commemorative works. I also offer cultural mediation group activities using clay, to approach the theme of « Befriending our mortality. »

In 1987 I was ordained Anglican priest in the Anglican Church of Canada. I am also trained and licensed to offer spiritual accompaniment. I worked in parishes for many years, first in Oakville ON, then in a Black congregation in Tulsa OK. When I moved to Montreal QC, I served in Lachine and then from 1999 to 2001, became the director of Centre Unitas, an ecumenical, bilingual spirituality and meditation centre in Montreal. In 2003, I became responsible for a First Nations mission in Odanak, then worked as a prison chaplain (CSC Drummond) all the while developing a French speaking ministry in Sorel-Tracy. From 1999-2015, I taught the course in Christian Spirituality at the ecumenical Montreal School of Theology. In 2015 I left full time ministry to begin to study ceramics.
